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SAN GENNARO The Saint and the Miracle

Throughout the year the city of Naples celebrates over fifty different Saints - but the Saint *Januarius* **San Gennaro** may be considered as the most important.

If you are new here to Naples, then the history and traditions regarding *San Gennaro* together with the alleged miracles may just be worth learning more about.

Three yearly events take place dedicated to the patron Saint *San Gennaro* and are not only religious celebrations but mass events which today continue to boast an enormous public participation. The annual dates are held on the Saturday before the first Sunday of May, on **September 19th** and December 16th and celebrated in central Naples at the "Duomo" Cathedral of Naples, *Museo del Tesoro di San Gennaro* and at the Sanctuary of San Gennaro where it is believed he was beheaded - *Santuario di San Gennaro all Solfatara*, situated at *Pozzuoli*. The traditional procession was originally established aiming to end the plague and passed from the *Solfatara* arriving to the Amphitheatre *Anfiteatro Flavio* to return to the statue of San Gennaro held within the Sanctuary. The "miracle" has been regularly recorded since year 1389.

Amongst many legends some historical foundations exist including the *Acta Bononiensia* document dated sixth century depicting his martyrdom under *Diocletan* in 305. *Januarius* travelled to *Miseno* to visit the deacon *Sossio* where he and his travelling companions were recognised as Christians. They were arrested but did not deny their faith, therefore after being sentenced to death were beheaded at the *Solfatara* the active volcano in *Pozzuoli*.

Regarding "the Miracle", the faithful and not only gather in Naples to witness the mystifying liquefaction of what is claimed to be San Gennaro's blood. Numerous legends depict that if the blood conserved within the glass ampoule fails to liquefy, then disaster will hit Naples. Coincidentally or not, disasters have actually struck on several occasions when the liquefaction failed - including the plague epidemic that struck *Pozzuoli* and the earthquake dated 1980 creating over 3,000 victims.

Many other "liquefying" events have been documented connected to the Saints *Pantaleon* and *Patrizia*, demonstrating a peculiar miraculous presence throughout southern Italy - an evident phenomenon virtually unheard of elsewhere.

Leaving legends to hypothesis, three Italian scientists; *Garlaschelli*, *Ramaccini* and *Della Sala* quoted after experimenting with various thixotropic mixtures that the glass vial may contain chemicals that were already easily available many years ago, and so offering a possible explanation to the famous phenomenon.

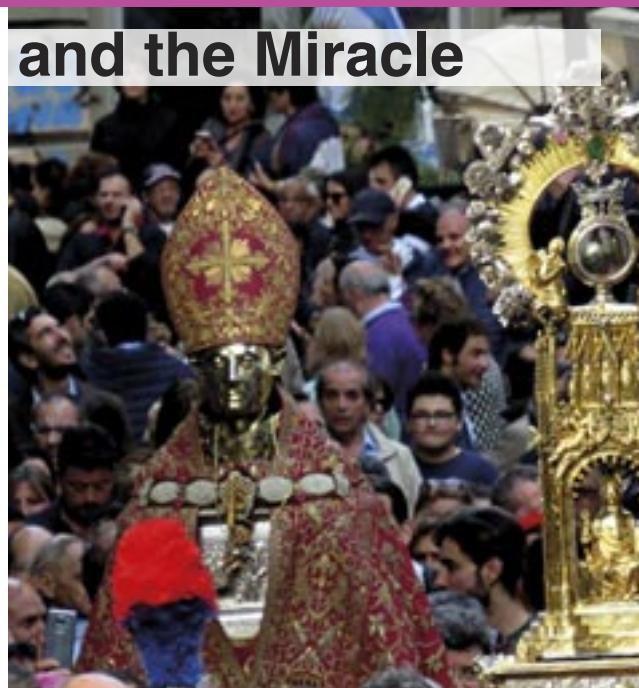
The annual *feast of Saint Gennaro* is also celebrated yearly in America. The first celebration took place in year 1926 on September 19th in New York City. The religious procession arrives to the National Shrine of San Gennaro.

"This Feast of San Gennaro holds a special place in the hearts of Italian people everywhere" commented Joseph Mattone, President of Figli di San Gennaro, Inc. "It is a festive period of faith and redemption, a time for remembrance and reconciliation and a time for celebration. The delicious food, the free musical entertainment that reflects Italian-American culture and heritage are all there. This Feast brings the World to Little Italy and Little Italy to the World."

Apart from New York, processions also take place at Los Angeles and throughout the world in San Paolo Brazil, Argentina and Sidney and Melbourne in Australia.

MUSEO DEL TESORO DI SAN GENNARO

MUSEO DEL TESORO DI SAN GENNARO

The Museum was founded in 2003 due to a project supported by European funds, by local institutions and private companies and is situated next to the Duomo of Naples.

The Treasure // *Tesoro* and vast collections of art works held within this museum covering over 700 square metres have been estimated as richer than the Crown Jewels belonging none other than to Queen Elizabeth II.

The collection of untouched works is guarded by an ancient institution - the *Deputation of the Royal Chapel and Treasure of San Gennaro* - which was established back in 1527 and is an organisation that still safeguards its preservation today. Two ampoules are held within the main altar of the Royal Chapel.

The Royal Chapel is part of the Cathedral but independent. Exhibits include jewellery, fabrics, paintings, frescoes, the renowned "*mitra*" - the Bishop's hat embedded with diamonds, rubies and emeralds and a priceless collection of numerous silver busts dating from 1305.

La Mitra gemmate di San Gennaro

The *Mitre of St. Januarius* adorned with jewels is considered as one of the most precious treasures in the world. Adorned with 3694 stones, 198 emeralds, 168 rubies, 3.328 diamonds and weighing 18 kilos it was used until 1931. Works including embedding, intricate embroidery and precious stone cutting were completed in just one year, created by *Matteo Treglia (Borgo degli Orefici)* together with 50 artisans. The masterpiece holds only three types of precious stones - emeralds representing knowledge, rubies symbolizing St. Januarius' blood and diamonds considered as strongest for faith.

SAN GENNARO CATHEDRAL & SANCTUARY

SAN GENNARO - THE CATHEDRAL

Naples Duomo Cathedral
Cattedrale di Santa Maria Assunta
 147, via Duomo - central Naples

Also known as the “*Duomo di Napoli*” but officially the “*Cattedrale di Santa Maria Assunta*”, this cathedral is most commonly called the “*Cattedrale di San Gennaro*” in honour of the Patron Saint of Naples - **San Gennaro** (*St. Januarius*) although actually dedicated to the *Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary*.

This breathtaking Roman Catholic structure was consecrated in the 13th Century, and today seats the Archbishop of Naples - displaying Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque and Neo-Gothic architectural styles, constructed upon the foundations of two palaeo-Christian basilicas. Successful excavations have revealed both Greek and Roman artefacts.



SAN GENNARO - THE SANCTUARY

SANTUARIO San Gennaro alla Solfatara
 8, via S. Gennaro alla Solfatara - Pozzuoli

The **Shrine of San Gennaro** at the *Solfatara* is considered as one of the most important places of worship throughout the Phlegraean **Campi Flegrei** area. The construction began in 1574 and was completed by 1580. The placement of this construction is believed to be exactly where *St. Gennaro* and his six companions were brutally beheaded for martyrdom, but other texts also depict the Solfatara Volcano together with the patron Saint of Pozzuoli - *San Procolo*.

The stone and bust - Local tradition guides visitors within the chapel to the stone situated on the right aisle. This sacred stone attracts pilgrims of all nationalities all year round - but concentrates upon the Anniversary dates of St. Gennaro's beheading and the alleged traces of ruby red blood visible upon the black stone.

SAN GENNARO CATACOMBS - VISIT INFO

SAN GENNARO - THE CATACOMBS

CATACOMBE DI SAN GENNARO

13, via Capodimonte - Naples

The *Catacombs of Saint Gennaro* are placed upon two levels and descend to the roots of Naples relationship with faith, devotion and ancient rituals. The original nucleus of this structure dates back to the 2nd century AD and originally a tomb of a supposed noble family amongst the Christian Community.

Expansion began two centuries later to hold the remains of the first patron of Naples - *San Agrippinus* and forming the underground Basilica. Five centuries later the tomb of *San Gennaro* was discovered within a cubiculum. The upper catacomb preserves some of the earliest Christian paintings present throughout southern Italy.

The Catacombs of San Gennaro is the only site of its kind throughout the world that is fully accessible. Various projects include routes for blind and visually impaired visitors using tactile exploration. In 2009 all architectural barriers were removed forming easily accessible walkways and ramps. My Country magazine highlighted the **Parco in Maschera** (*Parco Archeologico dei Campi Flegrei*) programme in last month's August edition - with a great choice of events, dance, music and theatre taking place throughout the Phlegraean Fields. Two archaeological icons of the territory - **Macellum (Tempio di Serapide)** and **Piscina Mirabilis** will host various upcoming events. The **Macellum** site, considered as one of the major symbols of *Pozzuoli* will host an innovative musical light show "Overture, verso il mediterraneo e oltre" organized by **ATI Macellum** and scheduled from dusk to Midnight on **25th and 26th September**.

The **Mirabilis** cistern is located in the higher part of *Miseno* and was the final point of the aqueduct connected to *Acquaro di Serino* situated in *Irpinia*. This unique and imposing structure measures 15 metres in height and 70 meters in length, originally supplying water to the major military port of *Misenum* and the imperial fleet *Classis Praetoria Misensis*.
